


From Clusters to Open Innovation Arenas





"It's the attitude that is important here: understanding, accepting and, as a result, exploiting the fact that boundaries are breaking down."

However, over time the boundaries have changed. Different industries have moved closer together naturally.









- 11 Guest researchers are developing projects in Sweden in 2016 and 1 will start in 2017 (CNPq-CISB-Saab 4thCall)
 - 8 of them are developing projects of CISB's portfolio in A&D




- 100 scholarships offered by Saab;
